

## Program Description

ATI's Trades Leadership degree is designed to develop critical thinking skills, communication abilities, and gain the broader perspective needed by managers. The AOS Degree option can be added to any of ATI's technical diplomas.

Trades Leadership course work focuses on foundational skills used by managers to oversee and elevate customer service, employee relations, team productivity, and inventory management.
