Program Description

The Commercial Driving - Class A Tractor Trailer Driving certificate program is designed to prepare students to meet the needs of the highway cargo industry. The classroom module prepares students for the written portion of the Commercial Driver's License (CDL) examination, provides information on driving safety, substance abuse, transportation of hazardous materials, trip planning, vehicle maintenance, and operational procedures. Students develop proficiency in backing, parking, and shifting tractor-trailer vehicles during the driving module. Graduates of this program will have met the Department of Motor Vehicle's educational requirements in order to qualify to take the Class A CDL Exam. ATI will support a student through three attempts to earn their Class A CDL Driver's License.
